



Fayette County Junior Fair Board Application & Program Guidelines

Purpose

The purpose of the Fayette County Junior Fair Board is to provide youth with the opportunity to develop leadership skills, participate in community service, and gain an understanding of the operations and management of the Fayette County Fair.

Application Process

1. Applicants must submit a completed application to the Fayette County Fair Board of Directors.
2. The Fair Board of Directors will review all applications and determine acceptance.
3. Applicants must return the signed agreement along with the completed application.
4. Applicants must reside in Fayette County, attend school in Fayette County, or be a member of a Fayette County 4-H Club.
5. Applicants must be between the ages of 15 and 21 at the time of application.
6. A parent or guardian signature is required for applicants ages 15–17.

Applications must be submitted by the announced deadline, September 14, 2026

Junior Fair Board Membership Guidelines

7. Members serve a 12-month term beginning October 1 and concluding the following September 30. Members must reapply annually.
8. Junior Fair Board members report to the Fair Board of Directors.
9. Officers (President, Vice President, Secretary & **Treasurer**) will be elected at the beginning of each term.
10. Members are encouraged to attend regular Fair Board meetings.
11. Members may present ideas and recommendations to the Fair Board of Directors.
- 12. Members are required to attend a minimum of six (6) Junior Fair Board meetings per year.**
13. A member of the Fair Board of Directors will be present at each Junior Fair Board meeting.
14. Members are representatives of the Fayette County Fair Association and are expected to conduct themselves accordingly.
15. The Fair Board reserves the right to remove any member whose conduct does not positively represent the Fair.

Service Requirements

- Complete a minimum of ten (10) service hours outside of fair week.
- Assist in planning and carrying out at least one fundraising or community event hosted by the Junior Fair Board to benefit the Fayette County Fair
- Work a minimum of two (2) days during fair week totaling at least ten (10) hours.

Agreement
